The Suramadu Bridge (Indonesian: Jembatan Suramadu), also known as the Surabaya-Madura Bridge, is cable-stayed bridge between Surabaya on the island of Java and the town of Bangkalan on the island of Madura in Indonesia. Opened in June 2009 and the 5.4-km bridge is the longest in Indonesia and the first bridge to cross the Madura Strait.



Sampoerna old house located in downtown Surabaya. Precisely located in Jalan Taman Sampoerna 6, Krembangan, Pabean Cantikan, Surabaya. The building was built in 1862 and originally became an orphanage run by the Netherlands. One of the orphans, Seeng Tee, buying a Dutch colonial-style building in 1932 for use as a large company producing cigarettes. One of the highlights here is to see directly the manufacture of cigarettes using traditional equipment and carried out by thousands of female workers who are able to produce 325 cigarettes per hour
